On the bill look for a National Meter Identifier/s (NMI). This NMI is a unique number assigned to the electricity meter at your address. Your NMI can be found on the front or back page of your bill. If you have more than one meter at your premise (for example if you have controlled load supply for hot water or another site location), there will be more than one NMI listed on your bill.

We will analyse SMART meter data to look at energy usage on an hourly basis over the previous 12 months, therefore getting a 'Fingerprint' of electricity usage.
